optional procedures (op)

- Optional procedures establish a method of accepting mail in which postage charges are verified by means other than weighing and where normal acceptance procedures are impractical.
- Postage verification is normally done by a USPS audit of records kept by the mailer as a normal requirement of business. A USPS audit is directed only at detecting underpayment.
- An OP Mailing System is a method of verifying and accepting First-Class, Standard, and Package Services permit imprint mail consisting of identical weight or non-identical weight pieces by comparing a mailer's financial, production, and other business records instead of by the standard weight verification procedures.
- The burden rests with the mailer to prove any overpayment of postage. Buse Printing is certified to do the P920.
